

# Frequently Asked Questions

## Do I get a seniors card from the Seniors Discount Club?

The discounts featured in this ebook are all available using your **government-issued seniors card**. You'll find more information on how to apply for one under the relevant section for your state or territory below.

Many of the other discounts we feature in our daily newsletter and on our forum are freely available to the public. This includes weekly deals from Coles, Woolworths, and Aldi.

## Can I get a hard copy of the discounts book?

The discounts book is only available electronically, but printing isn't a necessity since you'll simply need to present your Seniors Card at the relevant outlet to take advantage of the discount you are interested in.

## Why haven't I received my health insurance quote yet?

The health insurance quotes are provided telephonically, so you should receive a call within a few days of placing the request. If you haven't been contacted within a week, you're welcome to reach out to us at [contact@seniorsdiscountclub.com.au](mailto:contact@seniorsdiscountclub.com.au) or call 1300 757 819 for immediate assistance.

# How to Get the Most Out of Your Seniors Card

✓ Always check the standard retail price before asking for the discount or presenting your card.

✓ Have your Seniors Card number ready when making a booking or asking for a quote over the phone.

✓ Help to support the growth of the Seniors Card program by encouraging businesses in your local area to join.

✓ Shop around and compare prices on big-ticket items. Just because you can get a discount somewhere doesn't mean it will be the best price around.

✓ Present your card before payment in retail stores, cafes, and restaurants.

✓ Always ask if the business offers a Seniors Card discount before purchasing.

✓ If you find out that a business does offer a Seniors Card discount but there is no promotional material, let them know they can order promotional material from the relevant Seniors Card website free of charge. This will encourage more seniors to shop there.

# The Seniors Connected Programme

This is a government-run programme aimed at addressing loneliness in the older Australian community. The Seniors Connected Programme is a social outlet for those who may not have close friends or family living nearby and allows seniors to connect with each other.

These are its two main initiatives:

## ✔ FriendLine

FriendLine is a service operated by volunteers who offer friendly chats over the phone. The number is completely free to call and can be dialled between 10 AM and 8 PM daily. Call 1800 4 CHATS to speak to someone or visit the [FriendLine](#) website for more information.

## ✔ Village Hubs

Village Hubs exist to connect seniors (people over the age of 55) with each other in person. There are a number of hubs nationwide, so you can visit <https://www.ilaustralia.org.au/villagehubs> to find the one closest to you. # Territory

## Australian Capital Territory

You can apply for an Australian Capital Territory Seniors Card if:

- ✓ You're over the age of 60
- ✓ You're a permanent resident of the ACT
- ✓ You work less than 20 hours per week in paid employment

### Transport deals



COTA ACT manages Seniors Cards in the ACT and they are combined with Transport Canberra MyWay cards - one card allows for both discounted public transport, and the Seniors Card discounts and services.

With this MyWay card, concession fares apply at all times, with a weekday cap of \$4.80. Off-peak fares between the hours of 9 AM and 4.30 PM, weekend and public holidays are free.

## Interstate travel

The ACT is the first jurisdiction to link with the NSW Opal Card. This gives you access to concessional fares in NSW.

## When can I apply?

You can apply two months before your 60th birthday and your card will be issued when you turn 60.

## How to apply?



You can now apply for an ACT Seniors Card through [this handy web form](#).

When completing an application form, you are required to provide proof of age and residency.

Acceptable forms of ID include:

- ✓ Medicare card
- ✓ Centrelink Healthcare card
- ✓ Centrelink Pensioner Concession card
- ✓ DVA Healthcare card

Acceptable forms of proof of age include:

- ✓ Driver's Licence
- ✓ Birth Certificate or Extract
- ✓ Australian Passport

## Fees

There is no cost when applying for this card.

# Vehicle registration discount

Holders of ACT Seniors Cards are entitled to 10% discount on registration.

To claim a Senior Card holder concession on your vehicle's registration you can contact Access Canberra on 132 281. You will be required to confirm your details and provide your ACT Seniors Card number. You must present a current and valid ACT Seniors Card and primary proof of identity to an Access Canberra Service Centre or Shopfront. The concession can only be provided to the card holder. A concession can only be applied to one light vehicle registration in the card holder's name.

This means that you pay 10% less on the cost of the registration component but must pay the full fee for compulsory third party insurance, road rescue fee, road safety contribution and short term registration surcharge if applicable.

Seniors with gas or electric powered vehicles are entitled to 28% discount on registration.

# Frequently Asked Questions

## What is the Seniors Card programme?

The ACT Seniors Card is part of an Australia-wide initiative jointly supported by the ACT Government and Council on the Ageing (ACT). Each state and territory has a Seniors Card Scheme and some reciprocal arrangements are in place for using your card in other states and the Northern Territory.

The scheme recognises the valuable contribution of older people in their local community.

The ACT Seniors Card is issued free and provides access to savings on a range of goods and services provided by participating businesses.

A combination of government and non-government businesses make up the 300 participating organisations that provide a number of benefits and discounts on a wide range of goods and services.

## Where can I find out about available discounts?

Hundreds of businesses have signed up to offer discounts. [Click here](#) to see what you can save and where.

Also, look out for the 'Seniors Card Welcome Here' logo or ask for Seniors Card discounts when you're out and about.

## How do I update, replace or cancel a card?

You'll need to call the Access Canberra Contact Centre to manage your ACT Seniors Card. **Phone: 13 22 81**

## **Can I use my card interstate or overseas?**

Each Australian state and territory has their own Seniors Card scheme, but some reciprocal arrangements are in place. Double-check with the business that they offer a discount for ACT Seniors Card holders before making a purchase.

To find out more about participating businesses interstate, click on the state below.

Holders of the ACT Seniors Card have access to discounts and special offers on goods and services from some businesses involved in the New Zealand SuperGold Program. (This does not include transport concessions).

Look for the "SuperGold Cards Welcome" stickers when travelling in New Zealand, and ask if they also accept the Qld Seniors Card or Senior Savers Card. If a business does not offer discounts for Australian seniors, this will be noted on their website under 'exclusions'.

## **I am visiting from interstate or overseas. Can I use my card in the ACT?**

Use the online discount directory to find the business discounts currently available, but note that not all businesses extend their offers to interstate and overseas cards so ask before purchasing if they accept your card.







### Who is entitled to a New South Wales Seniors Card?

There are two cards available to Seniors in NSW, the Seniors Card and the Senior Savers card.

### Eligibility for NSW Seniors Card

- ✓ 60 or over
- ✓ Permanent Resident of NSW
- ✓ Doing **20 HOURS OR LESS of paid work** a week on average across 12 months (1,040 or fewer hours over the course of a year).

# Eligibility for the Senior Savers Card

- ✓ 60 or over
- ✓ Permanent Resident of NSW
- ✓ Doing **MORE THAN 20 HOURS of paid work a week** on average across 12 months (over 1,040 hours over the course of a year).

If you reduce your paid employment to 20 hours a week or less (averaged over 12 months), or you retire completely, you can convert your Senior Savers Card to a Seniors Card.

## Frequently Asked Questions

### What is the Seniors Card programme?

The programme was introduced in 1992 to acknowledge and show appreciation for the contribution of older residents to the community. It aims to improve the lives of seniors by aiding them with business discounts and government concessions when they retire.

## What is the Senior Savers programme?

The Senior Savers card was introduced much later (July 2019), for over 60s that are not yet eligible for a Seniors Card as they are working more than 20 hours per week. Holders of the Senior Savers card get access to the same business discounts but are not yet eligible for certain government concessions or discounts on public transport.

## Do I need both cards?

No, you will either be entitled to the Seniors Card or the Senior Savers card, having both cards has no extra benefit.

Also, look out for the 'Seniors Card Welcome Here' logo or ask for Seniors Card discounts when you're out and about.

## What should I do if I have lost my Seniors card?

If your NSW Seniors Card or NSW Senior Savers Card has been lost, stolen or destroyed and you need to replace it, you can do this online. You can do this by clicking the button below.

You will need to enter your details. You will also be asked for your Seniors Card or Senior Savers Card number, but you can still order a replacement if you don't have this number.

## **How do I change my personal details?**

## **Can I use my card interstate or overseas?**

Each Australian state and territory has their own Seniors Card scheme, but some reciprocal arrangements are in place. Double-check with the business that they offer a discount for NSW Seniors Card holders before making a purchase.

Holders of both the NSW Seniors Card and the NSW Senior Savers card have access to discounts and special offers on goods and services from some businesses involved in the New Zealand SuperGold Program. (This does not include transport concessions).

Look for the "SuperGold Cards Welcome" stickers when travelling in New Zealand, and ask if they also accept the NSW Seniors Card or Senior Savers Card. If a business does not offer discounts for Australian seniors, this will be noted on their website under 'exclusions'.

## **I am visiting from interstate or overseas. Can I use my card in NSW?**

Use the online discount directory to find the business discounts currently available, but note that not all businesses extend their offers to interstate and overseas cards so ask before purchasing if they accept your card.

## What government concessions am I eligible for?

If you hold a New South Wales Seniors Card, you may also be eligible to access some NSW Government Concessions.



## Can I use my card interstate or overseas?

Each Australian state and territory has their own Seniors Card scheme, but some reciprocal arrangements are in place. Double-check with the business that they offer a discount for NT Seniors Card holders before making a purchase.

Holders of both NT Seniors Cards have access to discounts and special offers on goods and services from some businesses involved in the [New Zealand SuperGold Program](#). (This does not include transport concessions).

Look for the "SuperGold Cards Welcome" stickers when travelling in New Zealand, and ask if they also accept the NT Seniors Card or Senior Savers Card. If a business does not offer discounts for Australian seniors, this will be noted on their website under 'exclusions'.

## I am visiting from interstate or overseas. Can I use my card in NT?







# State Queensland

There are three types of Seniors Cards available in Queensland. The standard Seniors Card, Seniors Card+go, and a Seniors Business Discount Card.

## Seniors Card

This card offers the following benefits:

- ✓ Eligibility for certain Queensland government concessions
- ✓ Discounts on goods and services at participating outlets throughout Queensland.
- ✓ Access to the free Senior Shopper service.

The Senior Shopper service is a free phone-shopping service that helps you get the best deal on electrical goods, travel, motor vehicles, computers, mowers, power tools, furniture, white goods, lawn bowls gear, fishing tackle, pools, cameras and more.

## Seniors Card +go

This card is for seniors who use, or plan to use, public transport in South East Queensland. It offers the same concessions and discounts as above, but also functions as a go card on Translink services:

To be eligible for a Seniors Card or Seniors Card+go you must be:

- ✓ Be a permanent resident of Queensland.
- ✓ 65 years or older and working less than 35 hours a week in paid employment

**OR**

- ✓ 60–64 years, working less than 35 hours a week in paid employment and the holder of one of the below:

- ✓ Commonwealth Pensioner Concession Card, which you can find more information about here

# Transport Discounts with the Seniors Card+go

You won't have to pay the usual \$5 deposit on the Seniors Card+go, and you will receive concession rates on trips using the TransLink services. A daily cap for Seniors is also in place: when you pay for two journeys in one day, you travel free for the rest of the day.

## Seniors Business Discount Card

If you're not eligible for the Queensland Seniors Card or Seniors Card +go, you may still qualify for the Seniors Business Discount Card, which offers:

- ✓ Discounts on goods and services at participating outlets throughout Queensland
- ✓ Be a permanent resident of Queensland.

## How to apply

There is one application process for all 3 cards. Once your application has been processed you will be issued with the card that you are eligible for.

You will receive confirmation when the application is processed, and the card will arrive in the post within 4 weeks.

## When can I apply?

You can apply two months before your 60th birthday and your card will be issued when you turn 60.

## What do I need to apply?

When you apply, you'll be asked for proof of age and address and will need to provide one of these four numbers:

1. Your Centrelink customer reference number (CRN)
2. Your Department of Veterans' Affairs file number
3. Queensland driver licence number
4. Queensland adult proof of age or photo identification card number

The name on your official document must be the same name used in your application.

## Fees

There is no cost when applying for these cards.

# Frequently Asked Questions

## What is the Seniors Card programme?

The programme was introduced to acknowledge and show appreciation for the contribution of older residents to the community. It aims to improve the lives of seniors by aiding them with business discounts and government concessions when they retire.

## What is the Senior Business Discount Card programme?

The Senior Savers card was introduced later. This card is for people over 60 years of age that are not yet eligible for a Seniors Card as they are working more than 35 hours per week. Holders of the Senior Business Discount Card get access to the same business discounts but are not yet eligible for certain government concessions or discounts on public transport.

## How do I update, replace or cancel a card?

Use the '[manage my card](#)' page to update, replace or cancel a card, upgrade from a Seniors Business Discount Card to a Seniors Card, or convert a card to or from a Seniors Card +go.

Register your go card to:

- ✓ Activate auto top-up or make a one-off top-up
- ✓ View your go card balance and travel history
- ✓ Update your account details and check your go card's expiry date
- ✓ Protect your balance if your go card is lost or stolen
- ✓ Transfer funds between go cards

## How do I change my personal details?

Use the 'manage my card' page to change personal details. If you have changed your name, you need to email or post in supporting documents to prove this.

## Can I use my card interstate or overseas?

Each Australian state and territory has their own Seniors Card scheme, but some reciprocal arrangements are in place. Double-check with the business that they offer a discount for Queensland Seniors Card holders before making a purchase.

Holders of both the Qld Seniors Card and the Qld Seniors Business Discount Card have access to discounts and special offers on goods and services from some businesses involved in the New Zealand SuperGold Program. (This does not include transport concessions).

Look for the "SuperGold Cards Welcome" stickers when travelling in New Zealand, and ask if they also accept the Qld Seniors Card or Senior Savers Card. If a business does not offer discounts for Australian seniors, this will be noted on their website under 'exclusions'.

## I am visiting from interstate or overseas. Can I use my card in QLD?

Use the online discount directory to find the business discounts currently available, but note that not all businesses extend their offers to interstate and overseas cards so ask before purchasing if they accept your card.

## What government concessions am I eligible for?

If you hold a Queensland Seniors Card or Seniors Card +go, you may also be eligible to access Queensland Government concessions.

Some of these include:

- ✓ Concessions that can reduce the cost of registering a vehicle or boat in Queensland for eligible applicants.

- ✓ Discount on a Stocked Impoundment Permit Scheme (SIPS). There are 63 impoundments (dams and weirs) in Queensland that require a SIPS permit to fish with a line. With a Seniors Card you will pay \$36 per year as opposed to \$50.

- ✓ Discount on Queensland rail travel to improve the affordability of long distance and urban rail services. Your SA Seniors Card entitles you to:

- ✓ free Adelaide Metro public transport during off-peak periods Monday to Friday and all day on weekends and public holidays.
- ✓ approximately 50% discount on Adelaide Metro public transport services at other times (7.00 am to 9.00 am and 3.00 pm to 7.00 pm Monday to Friday).

You'll need to validate your Seniors Card every time you board an Adelaide Metro bus, train or tram, even if it's in the free travel period.

If you plan to travel outside the free periods, you will need to top up your MetroCARD with at least \$5.

## When can I apply?

You can apply seven days before your 60th birthday or anytime after.



## Fees

There are no income or pension limits and the card is free of charge.







## Transport deals

The National Seniors Transport Scheme provides Seniors Card holders with concessions on public transport throughout Australia.

Tasmanian Seniors Card holders enjoy significant discounts and benefits on transport and travel including:

- ✓ Concession prices when using the Metro and Merseylink public transport services.
- ✓ Concession rate travel on metropolitan public transport in **all states and territories.**

If you are travelling to New South Wales, you will need to apply for an Opal Card before arriving.

## When can I apply?

You can apply on or after your 60th birthday.

## Fees

There is no cost when applying for this card.

# Frequently Asked Questions

## What is the Seniors Card programme?

The Tasmanian Seniors Card is a lifestyle card that enables holders to receive discounts from over 640 businesses and government services ranging from transport, electrical, and health care to accommodation, building supplies, clothing, dining, and much more. The Seniors Card is represented by a logo that is unique to the Seniors Card Program and used by all States and Territories.

By using this form you give your consent that your personal information can be forwarded to the Government services you are registered with, including the Seniors Card Program – don't forget to update your email address as well.

If you don't have the internet at home, please phone 1300 13 55 13 or visit your nearest Service Tasmania service centre.

If you require a replacement card due to a name change, please visit Service Tasmania with proof of your new name.

## **What should I do if I have lost my Seniors Card?**

Your Seniors Card does not expire and you do not need to renew or replace it unless it is damaged, lost or stolen.

To replace your Card free of charge:

- ✓ phone 1300 13 55 13
- ✓ visit any Service Tasmania service centre.

## **Can I use my card interstate or overseas?**

Each Australian state and territory has their own Seniors Card scheme, but some reciprocal arrangements are in place. Double-check with the business that they offer a discount for Tasmania Seniors Card holders before making a purchase.

Holders of the Tasmania Seniors Card have access to discounts and special offers on goods and services from some businesses involved in the [New Zealand SuperGold Program](#). (This does not include transport concessions).

Look for the "SuperGold Cards Welcome" stickers when travelling in New Zealand, and ask if they also accept the Qld Seniors Card or Senior Savers Card. If a business does not offer discounts for Australian seniors, this will be noted on their website under 'exclusions'.

## **I am visiting from interstate or overseas. Can I use my card in Tasmania?**

Use the online discount directory to find the business discounts currently available, but note that not all businesses extend their offers to interstate and overseas cards so ask before purchasing if they accept your card.





# State Victoria

## Seniors Card

### Eligibility:

There are two cards available to seniors in VIC, the Seniors Card and the Seniors Business Discount Card.

Eligibility for Victorian Seniors Card:

- ✓ Must be aged 60 or over
- ✓ Permanent resident of Victoria
- ✓ Must be doing 35 HOURS OR LESS of paid work a week on average across 12 months (1,820 or fewer hours over the course of a year).

When you are approved for a Victorian Seniors Card, you'll also receive a free Seniors Myki card which gives you discounted public transport.

## Eligibility for Victorian Seniors Business Discount Card

- ✓ Must be aged 60 or over
- ✓ Permanent resident of Victoria
- ✓ Must be doing 35 HOURS OR MORE of paid work a week on average across 12 months (1,820 or more hours over the course of a year).

This card does not include discounts on public transport, but still offers many of the same discounts as a Seniors Card.

When you reduce your paid employment to less than 35 hours a week (averaged over 12 months), or you retire completely, you can convert your Seniors Business Discount Card to a Seniors Card.

Permanent resident of Victoria means that your primary residence, at which you spend the majority of the year, is in Victoria.

## Benefits

Holders of both cards get:

- ✓ Discounts and deals at over 7,000 businesses state-wide.
- ✓ Reciprocal rights in other states - show your card and ask whether they offer a discount.
- ✓ Access to the Seniors Card e-newsletter

In addition, Seniors Card holders get:

- ✓ Exemption from needing a Fishing License to fish in Victorian waters.
- ✓ Access to discounted public transport with a Seniors Myki card.

A **Seniors Myki card** gives you access to:

- ✓ Concession fares (a 50% discount on full fares) on trains, trams and buses, including V/Line trains and coaches. Free travel on Saturdays and Sundays in two consecutive zones (e.g. Zone 1 and 2) and on regional town buses.
- ✓ Free travel on all Victorian public transport during the Victorians Seniors Festival. Including Melbourne trains, trams and buses and regional trains, coaches and buses. Tap on and off as usual during this time, but you won't be charged for the trips!



Seniors Card holders are also entitled to free travel vouchers each year. You will need to register to receive the free travel vouchers.

## At a local library (Seniors Card only)

If you are applying for a Victorian Seniors Card (NOT Business Discount Card) you can pick up an application form from your local library.

Once you have completed and submitted the application form, allow up to three weeks for it to be processed and for your card to get to you through the post.

What you need to apply:

- ✓ your postal address details
- ✓ your name and date of birth
- ✓ your valid green Medicare card details or Department of Veteran Affairs (DVA) card details

## When can I apply?

If you meet the other two criteria, you can apply for the Seniors Card OR Seniors Business Discount Card, three weeks before your 60th birthday.

## Fees

There is no cost when applying for either card; they are both free.

# Frequently Asked Questions

## What is the Seniors Card programme?

The programme was introduced in 1991 to acknowledge and show appreciation for the contribution of older residents to the community. It aims to improve the lives of seniors by aiding them with business discounts and government concessions when they retire.

## What is the Seniors Business Discount Card programme?

The Seniors Business Discount Card was introduced later, for over 60s that are not yet eligible for a Seniors Card as they are working more than 35 hours per week. Holders of this card get access to the same business discounts but are not yet eligible for certain government concessions or discounts on public transport.

## Do I need both cards?

No, you will either be entitled to the Seniors Card or the Seniors Business Discount Card, having both cards has no extra benefit.

## Where can I find out about the discounts available?

Hundreds of businesses have signed up to offer discounts. [Click here](#) to see what you can save and where.

Also, look out for the 'Seniors Card Welcome Here' logo or ask for Seniors Card discounts when you're out and about.

## What should I do if I have lost my Seniors card?

If your Vic Seniors Card or Seniors Business Discount Card has been lost, stolen or destroyed and you need to replace it, you can do this online.

You will need to enter your personal details. You will also be asked for your Seniors Card or Senior Savers Card number, but you can still order a replacement if you don't have this number.

## Can I use my card interstate or overseas?

Each Australian state and territory has their own Seniors Card scheme, but some reciprocal arrangements are in place. Double-check with the business that they offer a discount for Vic Seniors Card holders before making a purchase.

Holders of both the Vic Seniors Card and the Seniors Business Discount Card have access to discounts and special offers on goods and services from some businesses involved in the [New Zealand SuperGold Program](#). (This does not include transport concessions).

Look for the "SuperGold Cards Welcome" stickers when travelling in New Zealand, and ask if they also accept the Vic Seniors Card or Senior Savers Card. If a business does not offer discounts for Australian seniors, this will be noted on their website under 'exclusions'.

## I am visiting from interstate or overseas. Can I use my card in Victoria?

Use the online discount directory to find the business discounts currently available, but note that not all businesses extend their offers to interstate and overseas cards so ask before purchasing if they accept your card.
